Requirements/ Qualifications

1. Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education (KCSE) with a grade average of B, or equivalent.
2. Achieve English Proficiency test results with a satisfactory score of IELTS 6.5 with no band lower than 6.0, or equivalent.
3. Applicant should Preferably be resident in Kenya at the time of application.
